Randa v. Kortendick, L.C. 2013FA387

On May 5, 2025, Jacqueline Randa submitted an ex-parte e-mail communication to the Wisconsin Supreme Court Commissioners Office regarding a contempt hearing scheduled for Racine County Case No. 2013FA387, asserting that her "constitutional rights habitually are violated[.]"

The court notes that there is no appeal pending from any order in the circuit court case, nor has any other proceeding been commenced in this court concerning this matter. The court of appeals summarily dismissed a prior appeal in this case in 2023. *See In re marriage of: Jacqueline M. Randa v. Russell Scott Kortendick*, No. 2022AP1732, unpublished op. (Wis. Ct. App. Oct. 18, 2023), but no petition for review from that decision was filed in this court. As there is no basis for the court to exercise its jurisdiction over this matter,
