Before Stark, Presiding Judge, Judicial Conduct Panel

On February 7, 2025, the Wisconsin Judicial Commission filed a complaint against the Hon. Mark Powers. The Wisconsin Supreme Court referred the matter to the Court of Appeals, and on February 13, 2025, Chief Judge Maxine A. White appointed a three-judge Judicial Conduct Panel.

The complaint asserted that the answer to the complaint was due within forty-five days, citing WIS. STAT. § 802.06(1), which the Commission said was made applicable to these proceedings by WIS. STAT. § 757.85(7). To date, there have been no additional filings in this matter, such as proof of service of the complaint, an answer, or any other pleadings. A status update from the parties is required. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that by June 20, 2025, each of the parties shall file a written status update concerning this matter.
