
ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL

On February 26, 2025, Attorney Lew A. Wasserman filed a Notice of Appearance in this matter. A telephonic Scheduling Conference was conducted and a Briefing Schedule was established. Before the date the initial Brief was due, Attorney Wasserman filed a Motion to Permit Withdrawal as Counsel on May 5, 2025. I emailed counsel for OLR and Attorney Blumenthal inquiring whether either of them opposed the Motion. Both replied they had no objection. I replied by email on May 14, 2025 that I approved the request and inquired whether they intended to maintain the Briefing Schedule or proceed in another fashion. The parties have now arrived at a Stipulation for resolution of this matter. I am in the process of preparing a report for the Supreme Court finding one SCR violation and recommending the Court privately reprimand Attorney Blumenthal.

NOW THEREFORE, based upon the Stipulation of the parties:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Attorney Lew A. Wasserman's Motion to Permit Withdrawal as Counsel is GRANTED NUNC PRO TUNC.
