Robert Y. Stencil has filed a document in this court that is entitled “Petition to Bypass.” The document references two circuit court cases: (1) State v. Stencil, Brown County Case No. 2022CF892, and (2) State v. Stencil, Brown County Case No. 2022CF1062. Given the reference to two separate circuit court cases, the clerk of this court opened two miscellaneous matters—one for each circuit court case—and filed a copy of the “Petition to Bypass” into each miscellaneous matter. This order relates to Appellate Case No. 2025XX1259-CR and to Brown County Case No. 2022CF1062.

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action regarding the document entitled “Petition to Bypass.” A petition for bypass may be filed in an existing appeal that is pending before the court of appeals. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.60. There is, however, no appeal pending before the court of appeals regarding Brown County Case No. 2022CF1062. Thus, there is no appeal for which bypass could occur, and the document entitled “Petition to Bypass” does not properly invoke this court’s appellate jurisdiction and has no legal effect.
