On June 20, 2025, the court issued an order dismissing the petition for leave to commence an original action due to the fact that neither the filing fee nor a petition for waiver of the filing fee had been submitted as required by this court's May 16, 2025 order.

On July 2, 2025, petitioner, Shasta Casey Howell filed a document entitled "Notice of Appeal" and a signed Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs – Affidavit of Indigency. The court construes the "Notice of Appeal" to be a motion for reconsideration of the June 20, 2025 order dismissing the petition for leave to commence an original action.
