No. 2025AP1060-OA Howell v. State

On June 20, 2025, the court issued an order dismissing the petition for leave to commence an original action due to the fact that neither the filing fee nor a petition for waiver of the filing fee had been submitted as required by this court's May 16, 2025 order.

On July 2, 2025, petitioner, Shasta Casey Howell filed a document entitled "Notice of Appeal" and a signed Petition for Waiver of Fees/Costs – Affidavit of Indigency. The court construes the "Notice of Appeal" to be a motion for reconsideration of the June 20, 2025 order dismissing the petition for leave to commence an original action. The motion for reconsideration asserts that the petitioner failed to receive documents sent to her because she was released from the Rock County Jail and her mail was not forwarded to her, which the court finds to be good cause. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for reconsideration is granted, the June 20, 2025 dismissal order is vacated, and the matter is reopened; and
