No. 2024XX898-CR State v. Turner, L.C.# 2018CF727

On July 7, 2025, this court received a letter filed by defendant Paul A. Turner, pro se, that asks the court to “accept this letter as a timely but nonconforming petition for review pursuant 809.62 and 808.10 and allow two weeks to complete.” The letter appears to concern a June 4, 2025 order by the court of appeals. In that order, the court of appeals extended the time for Mr. Turner to file a notice of appeal or postconviction motion and declined to reconsider its earlier order denying Mr. Turner the appointment of counsel.

The court cannot construe the letter as a timely but nonconforming petition for review because the subject of a petition for review must be the final decision of the court of appeals. In Interest of A.R., 85 Wis. 2d 444, 270 N.W.2d 581 (1978). The court of appeals’ June 4, 2025 order is not a final decision, i.e., it does not finally dispose of the case in the court of appeals. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action on defendant Paul A. Turner’s letter filed July 7, 2025.
