On September 11, 2024, this court ordered a joint petition for bypass filed by the State of Wisconsin and the Guardian ad Litem to be held in abeyance pending this court's decision in Case No. 2023AP1950, State v. H.C. The court issued the decision in H.C. on June 3, 2025. That same day, the court ordered all parties involved to file simultaneous letters/briefs by June 17, 2025, discussing the impact of the H.C. case, if any, on the issues raised in the joint petition for bypass. Having reviewed the responsive filings, and noting the absence of any argument that this matter remains appropriate for bypass to this court following our discussion in H.C.,

IT IS ORDERED that the joint petition for bypass is denied, without costs.
