No. 2023AP1013-CR State v. Piovanetti, L.C.#2019CF311

On August 15, 2025, pro se petitioner, Jean Andre Piovanetti, filed a document captioned "Notice To The Clerk Of The Wisconsin Supreme Court, Of Appellant Intend To Ask For Review Of Court of Appeals Adverst Decision." In said document, Mr. Piovanetti appears to seek review by this court of certain non-final orders issued by the court of appeals or, alternatively, seeks to bypass the court of appeals as to the merits of his underlying appeal. To the extent Mr. Piovanetti seeks review of non-final orders of the court of appeals, the petition must be dismissed because this court review is limited to final adverse decisions by the court of appeals. Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62(1m); see also Henderson v. Rock Cnty. Dep't of Soc. Servs., 85 Wis. 2d 444, 446 270 N.W.2d 581 ("the order granting the motion for relief pending appeal does not finally dispose of the appeal and is therefore not reviewable by the supreme court"). To the extent Mr. Piovanetti seeks to bypass the court of appeals, his petition is also premature. See Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.60(1)(a) ("A party may file with the supreme court a petition to bypass the court of appeals pursuant to s. 808.05 no later than 14 days following the filing of the respondent's brief under s. 809.19 or response."). Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the August 15, 2025 petition filed by pro se petitioner, Jean Andre Piovanetti, is dismissed.
