On October 14, 2016, J. Denis Moran, Director of State Courts, on behalf of the Planning and Policy Advisory Committee (PPAC), filed a rule petition asking the court to amend Supreme Court Rule (SCR) 20:2.4 and create a new comment explaining the change. The petition proposes amending SCR 20:2.4 to create a new sub. (c) to allow lawyer-mediators to draft settlement documents in family cases. The Memorandum in Support of the petition sets forth the petitioner's reasons for seeking these changes and is available at [www.wicourts.gov/scrules/pending.htm](http://www.wicourts.gov/scrules/pending.htm).

IT IS ORDERED that a public hearing on the petition shall be held in the Supreme Court Room in the State Capitol, Madison, Wisconsin, on Thursday, January 12, 2017, at 9:30 a.m.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the court's conference in the matter shall be held promptly following the public hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice of the hearing be given by a publication of a copy of this order and of the petition in the official state newspaper once each week for three consecutive weeks,

and in an official publication of the State Bar of Wisconsin not more than 60 days nor less than 30 days before the date of the hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the full text of the proposed rules, including changes, if any, in existing rules, shall be placed on the Internet site maintained by the director of state courts for the supreme court. See [www.wicourts.gov](http://www.wicourts.gov).
