On November 25, 2016, Shannon Holsey, President of Stockbridge-Munsee Community, a federally recognized Indian Tribe, filed a petition asking the court to amend Supreme Court Rule (SCR) 40.05 to allow any legal services with any federally recognized Indian tribe be "counted" for purposes of SCR 40.05(1)(b), the "proof of practice" elsewhere option for admission to the Wisconsin bar. IT IS ORDERED that a public hearing on the petition shall be held in the Supreme Court Room in the State Capitol, Madison, Wisconsin, on Monday, September 25, 2017, at 9:30 a.m.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that notice of the hearing be given by a publication of a copy of this order and of the petition in the official state newspaper once each week for three consecutive weeks, and in an official publication of the State Bar of Wisconsin not more than 60 days nor less than 30 days before the date of the hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the full text of the proposed rules, including changes, if any, in existing rules, shall be placed on the Internet site maintained by the director of state courts for the supreme court.
