On May 15, 2019, by Attorney James E. Goldschmidt, on behalf of Quarles & Brady, LLP, filed a rule petition asking the court to restore Wis. Stat. § 802.05(2m) to its previous iteration to permit attorneys in limited-scope representations to assist otherwise self-represented persons in drafting a pleading, motion, or other filed document without disclosing the attorney's name or state bar number.
