On July 28, 2020 Attorney William C. Gleisner, III, Acting Secretary, on behalf of the Wisconsin Judicial Council, filed a rule petition asking the court to amend the Rules of Appellate Procedure, Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.85 to establish procedures for pro hac vice admission, substitution, and withdrawal of retained counsel in appellate court proceedings.

state newspaper once each week for three consecutive weeks, and in an official publication of the State Bar of Wisconsin not more than 60 days nor less than 30 days before the date of the hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the full text of the proposed rules, including changes, if any, in existing rules, shall be placed on the Internet site maintained by the director of state courts for the supreme court. See https://www.wicourts.gov/scrules/pending.htm.
