On October 21, 2021, a petition was filed by the Honorable Michael Bohren, Chair, on behalf of the Planning and Policy Advisory Committee (PPAC) Court Security Subcommittee. This rule petition asks the court to update Supreme Court Rule Chapter 68 to incorporate updated standards for courthouse construction, renovation, technology, and to better define county-level security and facility committee responsibilities. This petition also seeks to clarify the process for collecting data associated with court security threats and incidents.

IT IS ORDERED that a public hearing on the petition shall be held in the Supreme Court Hearing Room in the State Capitol, Madison, Wisconsin, on Tuesday, October 4, 2022, at 9:30 a.m.
