On July 15, 2022, the Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR), by its Director Timothy Samuelson and Trust Account Program Administrator Travis J. Stieren, filed a rule petition asking the court to amend Supreme Court Rule (SCR) 20:1.15 (Safekeeping property; trust accounts and fiduciary accounts) and SCR 20:1.0 (Terminology) to permit electronic transactions in lawyer trust accounts and to make other related changes to the rules governing lawyer trust accounts.
