# 2024-2025 GENERAL PROGRAM APPROVAL (GPA) SPONSORS

#### What is GPA?

GPA stands for "general program approval." The Board of Bar Examiners (BBE) grants general program approval to organizations who typically provide a high volume of continuing legal education courses and who have consistently demonstrated compliance with the standards required of those courses.

#### Who receives GPA?

Organizations interested in receiving a GPA designation must apply for it through the BBE. A listing of current GPA providers is included below.

## How do I know if I took a GPA course?

If you took a course that was sponsored by one of the organizations listed below, it is a "GPA course." If you took the GPA course in Wisconsin, it will appear on the BBE CLE website with the number of credit hours designated. However, if you took a GPA course outside of Wisconsin, it may not appear on our website and you will need to calculate the number of credit hours the course is eligible to receive.

## How do I calculate CLE credit hours?

To determine the number of credit hours, add the total number of minutes for the program. Then subtract any "nonacademic portions" (*e.g.*, breaks, business meetings, or other similar activities) and divide by 50. Be sure to round down to the nearest whole or half hour.

# Are GPA courses eligible for ethics and professional responsibility (EPR) credit?

Yes. GPA courses are eligible to receive EPR credit, provided they meet the relevant criteria, are submitted for EPR approval, and receive the approval.

## Where do I report my GPA courses?

GPA courses are reported under the "GPA Course Hours" section. For more detailed information about how to report these courses please review Section C of the CLE Electronic Filing Instructions.
