

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT
OF WALTER STERN TO PRACTICE LAW**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on Monday, September 21, 2015 at 9:00 A.M., a public hearing will be held before Referee Dennis Flynn at the Kenosha County Center, Conference Room B, 19600 75th Street, Bristol, Wisconsin, on the petition of Walter Stern of Kenosha to reinstate his license to practice law in Wisconsin. Any interested person may appear at the hearing and be heard in support of or in opposition to the Petition for Reinstatement.

On May 21, 2013, the Supreme Court of Wisconsin suspended Stern's Wisconsin law license for two years for committing federal criminal misconduct (conspiring to commit money laundering) and engaging in conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation. After spending roughly six months in federal prison, Stern's conviction was overturned.

To reinstate, Stern has the burden of substantiating by clear, satisfactory, and convincing evidence that (a) he has the moral character to practice law in Wisconsin, (b) his resumption of the practice of law will not be detrimental to the administration of justice or subversive of the public interest, (c) all of his representations in his reinstatement petition are substantiated, and (d) he has complied fully with the terms of the order of suspension or revocation and with SCR 22.26.
