


Navitus Generic Copay Waiver Program

Prescription drug costs are on the rise. For individuals with more than one chronic medical condition, taking multiple prescription drugs is not uncommon and can be costly. **Generic alternatives make brand name drugs available at more affordable prices with the exact same active ingredients.**

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) reviews all generic drugs. They approve the drugs using the same strict criteria used for brand name medications. The makers of generic drugs are not required to repeat the costly clinical trials brand name companies perform during the original approval process. The generic company is still required to prove that the generic version of the brand name drug provides the same benefits.

Navitus Health Solutions has developed the **Generic Copay Waiver Program** to help encourage members to use generic alternatives. This program allows members to have access to certain generic medications as another option to certain high cost, brand name drugs. A prescriber must first write a prescription for one of the products on in the program. Then, the member can present the prescription at the pharmacy. They will receive their first 30 day supply of the generic with a \$0 copay.
