Wisconsin Supreme Court to livestream March oral arguments and rules hearing

Madison, Wisconsin (February 26, 2026) – The Wisconsin Supreme Court announced today that it will livestream its March 10 and 11 oral arguments and the March 12 public hearing on a rules petition on the Wisconsin Court System homepage at wicourts.gov.

Last month, the Court funded and hosted a livestream of oral arguments to ensure continued public access to its proceedings. The Court will continue that approach for the March hearings. Chief Justice Jill Karofsky said the Court remains committed to providing reliable public access to its proceedings.

“These hearings involve issues that affect people across Wisconsin,” Chief Justice Karofsky said. “Livestreaming the arguments helps ensure the public can observe the Court’s work firsthand.”
