
Dear Ms. Wenzel:


I believe it is fair to say, there is no undoing the harm of the promises of Atty. Ham and his lack of follow through. My life would have been different if he had followed through and had been successful.

I have learned much in this experience. If I ever need a lawyer again, I will be cautious and make certain that I have a viable referral to go on.


