On December 7, 2017, Attorney Aaron Jeramie Loudenslager filed an administrative rule petition asking this court to amend Board of Bar Examiners (BBE) Rule 6.02 (BA 6.02) to "bring Wisconsin's character and fitness investigations with regard to prospective lawyers' mental health into compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)."

By order dated March 8, 2018, this court dismissed rule petition 17-10, but directed the BBE to review the issue and file a written report with the court by July 1, 2018, regarding whether BBE rules or procedures should be revised to ensure compliance with the ADA.

The BBE, by its Director, Jacquelynn B. Rothstein, has now filed a motion for extension of time to file the report on or before September 17, 2018. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED the motion is granted, and the Board of Bar Examiners shall file the report on or before September 17, 2018.
