Re: Rule Petition 19-11, In the Matter of the Petition of the OLR Process Review Committee's Subcommittee on Charging Process for an Order Creating Supreme Court Rules 22.02(6)(d), 22.05(1)(e), and 22.11(2)(b) and (c), repealing Supreme Court Rule 22.10(7)(b) and (c), Amending Supreme Court Rules 22.02(4) and (6)(a), 22.05(2), and 22.10(4), and Renumbering and Amending Supreme Court Rules 22.10(7)(a) and 22.11(2) (OLR Charging Process)

### Greetings:

In 2016, the Wisconsin Supreme Court established a committee to review Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) procedures and structure ("Committee"), and directed the Committee to report to the Court recommendations that would increase the efficiency, effectiveness, and fairness of the OLR process. The Honorable Gerald P. Ptacek was appointed as the Committee's chair. In October 2018, the Committee forwarded its final report to the Court. On March 13, 2019, the Committee filed nine administrative rule petitions, proposing various changes to existing OLR rules and procedures. This letter pertains to one of those rule petitions.

I am assisting the Wisconsin Supreme Court with its consideration of rule petition 19-11 filed March 13, 2019, by Judge Ptacek, Chair, on behalf of the Committee, and by Paul Schwarzenbart, Chair, of the Charging Process Subcommittee. This petition asks this court to modify its rules to improve communications between the OLR and grievants, streamline the procedures applicable to consent reprimands and to alleged breaches of a diversion agreement.

You have received this letter because you or your agency or organization has been identified as potentially having an interest in this matter. At the closed rules conference on June 6, 2019, the court conducted a preliminary discussion of this matter and voted to obtain written comments and schedule a public hearing. The public hearing will be conducted on December 9, 2019. Please note, the court may take any action on a rule petition it deems appropriate, including any of the following

(a) Adopt the rule proposed, or a modified version, without further comment.

- (b) Reject the rule proposed without further comment.
- (d) Refer the rule petition to another entity for its review and recommendation.
- (e) Request further information or analysis from the petitioner or interested persons or entities.

Any comment to the rule petition should be filed by October 28, 2019, with the Clerk of Supreme Court, Attention: Deputy Clerk-Rules, P.O. Box 1688, Madison, WI 53701-1688. If possible, email a Microsoft Word version of your response to *clerk@wicourts.gov*. *See* comment guidelines at the court's website at <a href="https://www.wicourts.gov/scrules/petitioncomment.htm">https://www.wicourts.gov/scrules/petitioncomment.htm</a>. The petitioners may file any response to the comments by November 12, 2019.
