Rebecca Clancy petitions the Supreme Court of Wisconsin to amend Supreme Court Rule 40.04(1)(b) to eliminate the requirement that an applicant who has received a degree in law from a law school whose graduates are eligible to take the bar examination of the jurisdiction in which the law school is located must first pass a bar examination and be admitted to practice in another state, territory, or the District of Columbia.

A memorandum in support of this petition is filed as a separate document.

I. CONTENTS OF PROPOSED RULE AMENDMENT

SECTION 1. SCR 40.04(1)(b) is amended to read:

SCR 40.04(1)(b) A law school whose graduates are eligible to take the bar examination of the state, territory, or District of Columbia in which the law school is located. ~~provided the applicant has passed the bar examination of and has been admitted to practice in that or another state, territory or the District of Columbia.~~

II. AUTHORITY

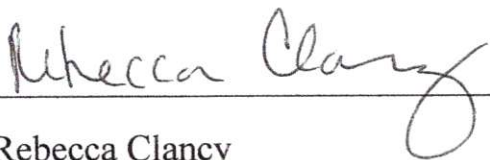
